Worship God for His creation. READ TOGETHER: 2 Samuel 6:16–23 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 3God is worthy of worship. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Psalm 150 What can we praise God for?	Create a collage with images that remind you of worshiping God.	PSALM 24:10 Why is God worthy of our worship?	Spend time worshiping God together through music.	Plan and create a family feast "fit for a king." READ TOGETHER: 2 Samuel 7 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?"
WEEK 4 God promised a forever King. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Isaiah 40:28 How do you feel knowing that God will never grow weary?	Create a "Family Covenant." Consider basing it on Scripture. Display it in your home.	PSALM 24:10 Will God's kingdom ever end?	Make a cross with two craft sticks. Write the words "Forever" and "King" across the sticks.
