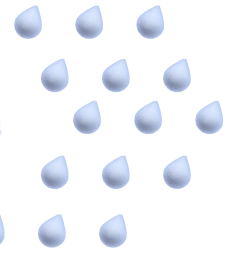

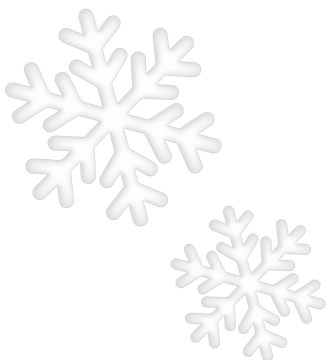

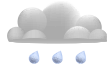

What does this mean for me?</p>	<p><b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Psalm 18:30 How can following God's way protect us?</p>	<p>Using telling a lie as an example, discuss the consequences of telling a lie versus telling the truth.</p>	<p><b>1 CHRONICLES 29:11A</b> What does this verse tell us about God?</p>	<p>As a family, take inventory on how you are doing being selfless, honest and generous with each other. Affirm each other in these areas and discuss how you can improve.</p>	<p>Play a game of hide-and-seek in your house. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Acts 8:26-40 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p><b>WEEK 2</b> -----</p> <p>God seeks us out. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p><b>READ TOGETHER:</b> 2 Peter 3:9 What does God want?</p>	<p>Play a game of pictionary, drawing someone whom Jesus loves and wants to know Him. Give each family member a turn.</p>	<p><b>1 CHRONICLES 29:11A</b> What/who belongs to God?</p>	<p>Take turns role-playing how to share the Gospel with someone.</p>	<p>Play thumb wars with your family. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Acts 12:3-19 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p><b>WEEK 3</b> -----</p> <p>God is powerful. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p><b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Matthew 19:26 What is possible with God?</p>	<p>Put yourself in the story. Imagine you were one of the people praying for Peter. How would you have reacted?</p>	<p><b>1 CHRONICLES 29:11A</b> How does this verse describe God's power?</p>	<p>Draw Bible stories that demonstrate God's power. Post the pictures on your refrigerator as a reminder of God's power.</p>	<p>Discuss: What is your favorite possession? Why? <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Acts 17:16-34 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p><b>WEEK 4</b> -----</p> <p>God is the one true God. What does this mean for me?</p>	<p><b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Romans 1:22-23 Why is it foolish to worship created things?</p>	<p>Write things that are important to your family on cards. Arrange them in order of importance. Talk about why God should be the most important.</p>	<p><b>1 CHRONICLES 29:11A</b> How does this verse describe God?</p>	<p>Talk about how you can put God first as a family.</p>	<p>Spend time affirming each person in your family. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Acts 18:18-28 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?</p>

Mention who told you about God and how that made a difference.</p>	<p><b>1 CHRONICLES 29:11A</b> How should we live knowing everything belongs to God?</p>	<p>Make cards for someone you know who needs encouragement. Include character traits you know about God.</p>	<p>Eat some fruit together. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Galatians 5:13-26 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?</p>
